

DATA PROTECTION REGULATIONS

ZC3 values the protection of everyone's privacy. Please refer to the following privacy policy.

1. Data collection and data processing

Pursuant to Section 2 of Law 235.1 on the Protection of Persons and Other Subjects, with regard to the use of personal data, we would like to inform you that the personal data provided by you or collected by other means in the course of our business activities will be used digitally by Zurich Triathlon GmbH in compliance with the aforementioned law for administrative, statistical, commercial purposes as well as in the context of marketing measures or commercial communications. In accordance with Art. 8 of Law 235.1, you may access this data at any time, request its modification or deletion, or prohibit its use. Authorized to use the data is Zurich Triathlon GmbH and its partners required for the implementation.

1.1. Storage of personal data

The personal data provided by the participant upon registration will be stored and processed for purposes of implementation and handling of the event. This includes the transfer to contracted service providers and medical services. With the registration the participant agrees to a storage of the data for these purposes.

1.2. Photos / Filming

The photos, film recordings and interviews of the participants made in connection with participation in the event in radio, television, print media, Internet, books, reproductions (analog or digital films, digital data carriers, etc.) may be distributed, processed and published by the organizer without any claim to remuneration. This within the scope that other legal regulations are kept. The participant agrees that personal data of a company commissioned by the organizer, which takes photos during the competition, will be passed on for sending the photos.

1.3. Participants list publication

Personal data of the participant will be printed or published for the presentation of result lists and the current registration status in all relevant media accompanying the event. By registering, the participant agrees to the storage, publication and use of personal data for this purpose.

1.4. Disclosure of personal data

The participant may object to the disclosure of his/her personal data to the organizer in writing or by e-mail.

2. Cookies, tracking and other technologies related to the use of our website

The data protection declaration applies to the zurichcitytriathlon website. For Internet offers of third parties, to which this site refers by means of tools and links, no responsibility is taken for compliance with data protection regulations.

In principle, you can use the site without having to provide any personal information. During your visit, ZC3 can only register impersonal usage data. In so-called log files, the IP address of your computer or network, the last page visited, the browser used, date, time and downloaded files may be recorded. They are collected for the purpose of analyzing user behavior and ultimately serve to optimize our offer. No conclusions about your person can be drawn from this.

2.1. Specification and use of personal data

You can only use certain offers on the site if you provide personal data. For some offers it is sufficient to name your e-mail address (e.g. newsletter), for other services we require you to provide your surname and first name, address, telephone number and e-mail address. As a debt collection company, ZC3 is obliged for legal reasons to be able to document all transactions in a traceable manner during the statutory periods. We treat your personal data in accordance with the applicable data protection law. This means that ZC3 undertakes to use personal data carefully and exclusively for the purposes indicated. ZC3 receives the right to use the postal address, e-mail address and mobile number for the delivery of information about events, products, services or other offers. You have the possibility at any time to correct the personal data entrusted to us or to limit their use by notifying us by e-mail or by mail. Exception: The names and places of residence of participants and supporters of past events published in the ranking list cannot be changed or restricted.

2.2. Visitor identification

Occasionally, information may be stored on your computer that can identify you. Such information is referred to as "cookies". These text files stored on your hard disk do not contain any personal data, but make it easier for you to use our Internet pages: Thanks to cookies, we can provide you with the personalized content you want without requiring you to log in each time you visit. You can configure your browser so that a warning appears on the screen before a cookie is saved. Or you can reject cookies in principle. However, certain services cannot be used in this case.

2.3. Security

The data obtained during registration or payment will be SQL encrypted, used for the events and not made available or forwarded to third parties.

The provision of personal data via the Internet is always associated with risks and no technological system is completely safe from manipulation or sabotage. ZC3 will attempt to take reasonable precautions to prevent unauthorized access to, use or falsification of your personal information and to minimize the corresponding risks. For Internet payments, the security standards of the payment providers apply.

2.4. Changes

In view of technical developments on the Internet, ZC3 is continually expanding its online offering. At the same time, we check whether additions or changes to the privacy policy are necessary as a result. ZC3 may at any time - even without notice - adjust these rules or the content of the website or change or block access to the site. We will publish any modifications on the zurichcitytriathlon.ch platform.
